Covid safety in Nursery

We want to reassure all our families that we are going above and beyond to ensure our children and staff are Covid safe. To minimise risk of transmission we are continuing to ensure the following;

Bubbles; we are minimising contact as much as possible throughout the nursery. Children and staff remain in their 'bubbles'.

Robust hand and respiratory hygiene; the children are washing hands upon entrance to nursery, at regular intervals throughout the session and before the children leave us at home time. They are also encouraged and supported to hand santitise frequently.

Enhanced and stringent cleaning routines and ventilation; we continue to deep clean toys, resources, classrooms and other areas throughout, and between each session. Windows and doors remain open throughout the day to ensure ventilation.

Limiting visitor contacts; any visitors needing to attend are asked to wear full PPE and remain at a 2m distance from children and staff.

Please continue to follow the **COVID-19 guidance**. We will continue to take temperatures and ask you to keep your child away from school for 48 hours if their temperature is high. Please do not bring your child to school if you are isolating and do not bring onto site any household members who are isolating.

Thank you all for your continued support in wearing masks when on the school grounds and also keeping a 2m distance when waiting for your children to enter, or leave nursery.
