All parents/carers of children new to Sandy Lane this year were invited to complete a short survey about nursery and how their child has settled in. Thanks to everyone who took time to complete the questionnaire, your views are important to help us continue to improve as well as celebrate the things we do well.

Here is my analysis of your responses as well as replies to the comments made.

1. If a home visit too place prior to your child attending for their first visit at nursery, did you find this useful?

In what ways do you think it helped both you and your child?

Yes, I think meeting Jo and Sarah beforehand helped put me at ease for Jenson starting. I found the home visit very useful. Thanks to this, my child met teachers with whom he has classes in the nursery. As a parent, I also felt better getting to know the staff before my daughter's first day in the nursery.

Very useful, it was lovely to get to meet some of the team at the nursery who were very friendly and made Niall feel at ease.

Very useful Kirsten took ages to chat with us and ease any worries

Lovely to meet the staff and ask any questions

Yes this was useful. Allowed us as parents to give a bit of a background about our child and get our thoughts and concerns across. It also gave us some insight of the routine of his day and helped us understand the processes that would happen over the next year up to school

It allowed S to see a familiar face when starting nursery. Also allowing nursery to see S in her own home environment and finding out what her likes/dislikes are to help the transition smoother

My J learned bit of language and also improved in many other ways.

Yes, it enables teachers to see James in his home environment and understand his behaviour, temperament and additional needs in his familiar surroundings, which helps staff prepare for him in at preschool.

The visit enabled me to give staff detailed information about his additional needs, likes and dislikes.

J was able to meet some staff and spend some 1:1 time with Nic, which may have helped him settle quicker, having a familiar face.

L had greater confidence starting his new nursery with the home visit. I feel he knew where he could seek assistance with familiar faces.

I felt comfortable meeting his teacher and her assistant at home prior to his nursery placement. It gave us all great confidence on his new journey.

A had a chance to meet the people who would be caring for her with her home surroundings which made A less anxious.
